The Test

I'm glad to hear the young ones are studying the First Commandment. The Commandments as a whole are fundamental building blocks of our Faith, and indeed, our American culture. Did you know that the 10 Commandments use to be in every public-school classroom in America? That was ended in 1980 by the Supreme Court. Separation of Church and State was the reason given. Previously, the Supreme Court ended public school prayer in 1962, and then took Bibles out of the classrooms in 1963. I wonder what effect the absence of these three cultural anchors have had on our classrooms? I present this bit of information to you as a follow-up on my last letter about Cultural Marxism, and the teachings of Antonio Gramsci, and to illustrate the slow but steady decline of American values. Anyway, let's move to the main purpose of this letter.

As we teach our children their faith, I always find it a good opportunity to fix our own position, to determine how we are keeping the faith. Are we following what we are telling our children to follow? I'll confess freely, it is during these "self-assessments" that I find many problems in my own faith. So don't feel to disheartened at the results, instead consider the test as a blessing, a guidepost in living your own life. Something that has the ability to bring you closer to God, while at the same time helping you to instill a stronger belief, and practice of the faith in your children. So, here goes.

The Test of the First Commandment - I Am the Lord thy God, Thou shall not have strange gods before Me, (CCC Pt. 3 Sec.1)

Tell me now, how do we keep the Sabbath? Do we keep it holy as was intended? Do we give honor to God, or do we treat Sunday as another day of the week, focused only on our affairs?

Carefully answer me, do we keep the Lord's name holy? Do we treat the name of the Lord with love and respect, or do we abuse it in our speech and thought, taking false oaths that perjure ourselves before God. Answer me truly, do we make idols out of our interests, our worldly pursuits? Idols that have an undue influence on our life, that shape how we think, how we act; idols that consume our time and energies, at the expense of distraction from our God? Examine yourself carefully now. In what manner do we live our life? In what do we place most importance, and give our attention to? Do we live our life in vain superstition? Do we attach importance to some magical way, or formula, to live our life, or do we place ourselves confidently in the hands of Divine Providence?

Explain to me, how do we approach Holy Communion? Do we believe we are receiving the true Body and Blood of our Savior Jesus Christ? Or do we approach communion as just a symbol of Christ, nothing more? Do we keep the fast before Communion? Are we in a proper state of grace?

On what do we place our hope and confidence? Is it to mankind that we turn to for wisdom, or to God? Is our religion centered on the seemingly endless knowledge we derive from science, and unraveling the mysteries of nature? Do we worship the creation, or the Creator?

And so the test goes. You will find in this test, elements of the second and third Commandment, which together with the first Commandment form the so called "Duties to God" Commandments.

So, take time to ponder the lessons we teach our children. Make sure we are living what we teach, for the most important lesson children learn from their parents, is the lesson of example.
