Our Daily Bread – The Fishing Hole

Simon Peter said to them, “I’m going fishing”. They said to him, “We will go with you.” John 21:3..... ***Well of course they did!***

Fishing was a part of life growing up in rural Kentucky. Not only was it a lot of fun, it was part of making do. When we went fishing, we were expected to catch and bring home fish. With a little corn meal and flour, along with whatever the garden was producing, fish was the center of many a fine meal. In that experience, I learned all types of fishing methods, from cane pole fishing with a bobber, to casting and working the lure. I also learned how to bait a fishing hole, run trot lines, and build different fish traps. Legal? Well, not exactly. Effective? Very.

I remember well the first hole I baited with dad. He took a bail of alfalfa and we weighed it down and sank it at a fairly good fishing hole. After a time, fish started feeding around the bail. The feeding activity brought in many more fish, and we had hours of great fun at that hole all year. Later in life, I always tried to find time at sea to have a fish call. Anytime we were running ahead of schedule and happened upon a sea buoy, we would chum around the buoy for half an hour or so, and then announce fish call. There was always something to catch. Once upon a time in the middle of the Gulf of Mexico we did that around a NOAA buoy, and were hauling in yellow fin tuna for two solid hours.

Alaska was always a great place to fish. There is a patch of water in and around Albatross Banks just south of Kodiak Alaska, that was famous for Halibut. The last time I fished that hole was around midnight on the way to the Aleutian Islands and the Bearing Sea. Yes, even at mid-night with a steady freezing rain, the fantail was full of fishermen. Years earlier on a small patrol boat, I remember we would take time to bait shrimp traps and set them out in deep water, and come back to them the next day to collect tiger shrimp (8-10 count). Repeat the process for a few days, throw in a fish call or two, and you have the makings for an excellent Friday seafood dinner.

So many memories. My favorite? That’s easy, fishing with the kids. I remember taking them on the vacations to Smith Mountain Lake, and fishing on the pier at the cottage. I remember taking them out on that old pontoon boat and teaching them to troll the points for Bass. Of course, the big fish fry on Friday night. Mom still talks about that. I remember taking the kids in the evening to the local lake to fish. It was at the end of a dead-end road that led down to the water. If you remember the opening to the Andy Griffith show, where Andy and Opie were walking along the lake, then you can picture what we looked like. At the end of the road, we came upon a fair bluegill hole where it was easy to hook bluegill, pumpkinseed and other sunfish. I confess I spent most of the

time baiting hooks and clearing tangles and such, but the look on their face and the cry of joy of catching the fish was a wonderful experience. Through it all, I can hear my own dad’s laughter and see his smile. Such is the powerful experience of fishing.

Is it any wonder that Jesus was drawn to Capernaum, by the Sea of Galilee, to find His first disciples? They were fishermen, use to being outdoors in all weathers; use to hard work and use to coming up empty at the end of the day, only to give it another try the next morning. They were persistent and always hopeful. When everyone else would give up and leave, a fisherman is always thinking about the next cast.

Disagree? Read Luke chapter 5. After having Peter pull off the shore in his boat so our Lord could teach, Jesus told Peter to cast his net. Peter protested saying that they had fished all night without catching a thing, but if you say so, I will do it. Of course, they went on to do what Jesus said, and caught more fish than they knew what to do with. But the initial reply of Peter to Jesus is key to understanding why Jesus chose fishermen. For in Peter’s reply we hear, “I am tired, I am frustrated, but I am going to try once more based on the word of someone I do not even know”. Fishermen are incapable of accepting defeat. They will never give up trying.

How good of a fisherman are you?
