

Our Daily Bread – The Frosted Window

It's 4:30 AM Friday Morning, a cup of coffee in hand and going through the days work in my mind, while watching it snow. The light off the back deck reveals a winter show that's hard to ignore, large flakes of snow coming down at a good rate; the ground already covered in a white blanket. So, before you know it, I am transported to another time.

It's my old bedroom in the house I grew up in. Located on the second floor it was just a bit bigger than a walk-in closet, just enough room for a small bed. The foot of the right side of the bed was pushed against a single pane window that led out on the roof. I lived my childhood by the window. In summer time, before anyone heard of air conditioning, I would crawl through the window on the hottest nights, and sleep outside on the roof on a small tin saddle where the two sections of the house met.

That same window showed me bright sun filled mornings and soft evenings, where the filtered twilight would come through, transforming my little room with a warm glow. That window brought to me the four seasons of the year in all their different moods. It was by that window on a rainy night I would be lulled to sleep listening to the rain hit that tin saddle, safe in knowing the window would keep me dry.

On a cold winter night though, the window would frost and ice up terribly both inside and out. The ice was able to do what the rain could not, and I would tuck my feet up close to get away from that ice. Dad had later installed a gas heater on the second floor, and on really cold nights, when there simply were not enough blankets, coats and towels to cover up with, I would abandon the cold bed and sleep as I could at the foot of that heater, its warm glow and soft humming sound stood in stark contrast to the silent icy window just a few feet away, dark, cold, ominous.

But its not a horrible memory. That frosted window on the next morning would provide me with a magnificent display of nature's handiwork. On most days it was only jack frost on the other side, but on occasion it was a winter wonderland of snow. It would cover and weigh down the branches of the old ash tree, and birds would be working over the snow-covered ground pecking for something to eat at the foot of the trees. Further out, beyond the back yard, the woods would be transformed by the snow. That old window would call me to come out of the house and explore; which I did.

Quickly through the back yard and into the woods, down the valley past the old tar paper covered shacks with their barking dogs, down and over the iced covered creek and climbing up to the next ridge. Beyond lay endless farm land and fields, that seem to stretch on forever. All these memories and what's more the experience, provided by the invitation of that frost covered window.

A good window will do that you know. It provides an invitation to get out and live in the world. To experience it. To be part of it. That is what we are created for.

Don't get trapped in a bedroom, or find yourself laying in a comfortable fetal position at the foot of a heater, lulled into sleep by its warmth and sound. Get out of you room and experience life.
